G. PUBLIC HEARINGS:

For items listed, the public will be given an opportunity to speak and present testimony. After presentation of the staff report, the Chairperson will open the public hearing. At that time, the applicant will be allowed ten (10) minutes to present the case. Members of the public will then be allowed three (3) minutes each to speak. After all have spoken the applicant is allowed three minutes to summarize, and then the chairperson will close the hearing. Commissioners may ask the speaker and staff questions. Those questions will not be counted against the applicant's time limit.

1. Conditional Use Permit No. 2016-03 for a Planned Unit Development filed by Lennar Inc. proposing to allow modification of side yard, rear yard, and lot coverage requirements for lots 1 to 100 of Tract No. 5383 (Royal Woods). Project has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section

15305 of the CEQA Guidelines – Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations

- 2. Zoning Amendment No. 2015-12 proposing to Amend Sections 90-122 (Urban Reserve District) and 90-182 (Single Family Residential Agricultural District) of the Sanger Municipal Code to allow Farmworker/employee housing. Amendment No. 2015-12 has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15305 of the CEQA Guidelines Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations.
- 3. Zoning Amendment No. 2015-13 proposing to add Section 90-899 Reasonable Accommodations to the Sanger Municipal Code establishing a procedure for individuals with disabilities to request reasonable accommodation in seeking equal access to housing under the federal Fair Housing Act and the California Fair Employment and Housing Act. Amendment No. 2015-12 has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15311 of the CEQA Guidelines Accessory Structures
- 4. Zoning Amendment No. 2015-09 amending Sanger Municipal Code Section 90-894 (5) related to Second Residential Units in the R-1-10 (Single Family Residential, 10,000 square foot minimum lot size); R-1-7.5 (Single Family Residential, 7,500 square foot minimum lot size); and the R-1-6 (Single Family Residential. 6,000 square foot minimum lot size) Zone Districts. Amendment No. 2015-12 has been determined to be exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15305 of the CEQA Guidelines Minor Alterations in Land Use Limitations.
